SUBJECT: PULVERIZATION OF LOCAL ROADS

POLICY: If the Road Commission determines a local road needs to be pulverized back

to gravel due to excessive placement of road patch material and/or a safety concern, the manager will make recommendation to the Road Commission

Board.

Upon approval by Road Commission board the roadway will be pulverized and an appropriate amount of gravel will be placed as determined by the Road Commission.

Written notification will be provided to the township board. Construction activities will not commence until a minimum of 30 days after notification.

All material and outside contractor costs for the gravel will be deducted from future township(s) allocation allotments as provided by the Road Commission.
