REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL

2017 As-Needed Wetland Mitigation Services

(Not to exceed 2 years)

The Midland County Road Commission is seeking professional services for Wetland Design, Construction assistance and monitoring for a variety projects. Projects may be added or deleted as needed. If your firm is interested in providing services, please indicate your interest by submitting a proposal.

Consultants and their sub-consultants shall be experienced in MDOT Wetland design, construction and have monitoring experience. Submittal shall be limited to 1-2 page description of how the company can best provide services for Midland County Road Commission and resumes of Designers with MDOT Wetland design experience that are proposed to provide assistance to the county on an as needed basis. Provide relevant experience, summaries of similar projects, and typical cost. Also provide your firm's rate schedule for services associated with this proposal.

The following is a partial listing of anticipated projects based on current information, and is intended for informational purposes only:

- Wetland mitigation site in the Sturgeon Creek watershed for the extension of Mier Road.
- Wetland mitigation site for extension of Castor Road to Magruder Road in the Carroll Creek watershed.

Each proposal shall be submitted via email or envelope. The submittal shall contain the details of the fee schedule to complete the items contained within the Scope of Services for this proposal request. Each envelope shall be labeled "**Midland County Road Commission – 2017 As-Needed Wetland Mitigation Services**".

The Consultant/Consultants will be selected using a qualification based selection process. The selection team will review the information submitted and will select one firm considered most qualified to perform the services based on the proposals. The selected Consultant/Consultants will be contacted to confirm capacity. Upon confirmation, negotiations will be conducted with the firm/firms selected. Plans for state/federal Aid projects shall meet all MDOT current guidelines and standards. Plans for 100% local funded projects will be determined project by project.

Proposals are due on March 3, 2017 at 9:00 AM.
