# Staff Reports:

Jon stated the DDIR's for the FHWA flood projects are being developed through the MDOT contract with the Spicer Group.

We have not received a FEMA declaration yet, but information has been submitted.

He met with the USDA, Energy Watershed Protection Program, on a few flood sites for possible funding.

He held meetings with the Townships last week to discuss funding. They will be prioritizing their projects and getting back to us.

He is working on millage renewal information to be presented to the Midland Business Alliance on July 20<sup>th</sup>.

Art stated we will start the Meridian Road bridge south of Kent Road over the Bullock Creek next week.

The second round of brine has been moved up to start on July 20<sup>th</sup>.

Ben stated the shop has been very hot lately and he has purchased a couple large fans for the mechanics to keep the air moving.

He is working on additional strobe lighting for the chipper, rewiring on the brine tanker, some air conditioner repairs, and brake jobs on equipment.

The mechanics have been cleaning the arrow boards and changing batteries.

The swap loader has been delivered to Truck & Trailer for assembly.

The safety committee met this week for the first time since COVID.

The new mower tractor came in \$6,000 under bid price due to a reduction in MiDeal Contract.

Ashley stated she is working on some updates for the new complaint call system, SeeClickFix. The proof for the updated county map will go out today.

She is putting out counters and working on traffic counts.

Russ stated he is finalizing the millage brochure and it should be mailed out the week of July 20<sup>th</sup>.

Commissioner Atton commented on the great job the mower students are doing this summer.
