Staff Reports:

Jeff reviewed the 2nd round of material bids that he is preparing to advertise. He stated that he attended the County Engineers Workshop in Muskegon last week. He has spent a lot of time finishing up Right of Way permitting for fiber projects, but they are complete.

Donna stated that she has been busy with audit prep, gathering the required documents and sending them to the auditor. He will be beginning the audit in the next two weeks. She also stated that she is thrilled with the office construction process that is underway and thanked everyone for their patience with the mess.

Steve reported a few minor equipment repairs. He also discussed the office construction process and stated that he is very happy with the professionalism and work of C3 Construction. Steve updated the board on the delivery of the Hydroseeder, which may be next week if the weather is good.

Art stated that we have begun receiving some of our backup salt. We have 1000 tons on order that will be coming in as Detroit Salt can get it shipped out. The break in the weather has allowed

the crew to work on some maintenance items that were behind due to the heavy winter weather. Art reported that he has attended several meetings recently, including the Superintendent's Meeting, the annual meeting with the DNR, and an LEPC meeting at Midland County. He stated that the 2nd round of First Aid/CPR was completed last week with the remaining crew.

Jon discussed the County Engineers Workshop in Muskegon that he attended last week and stated that this year's information was very relevant. Jon also attended the annual DNR meeting with Art. He informed the board about the MDOT Open House that was held here at the Road Commission office this past week. Jon also updated the board on the progress of the Bailey Bridge and stated that he had a meeting regarding the bridge later in the day. He also mentioned an upcoming RTF meeting, a meeting with the Drain Commission, and the Prairie Road Urban project GI meeting, all within the next week.

Travis stated that he had also attended the County Engineer's Workshop in Muskegon last week. He reported that he has been working on Standard Typical Road Cross-sections.
